

FY23 H1 trading highlights and business update



- The recapitalisation became effective 26 January 2023 giving the Group access to £75m of additional liquidity and delivering a substantial deleveraging of the balance sheet.
- H1 FY23 admissions 34.3m, 75% of the H1 3yr average FY17-FY19.
- Revenue of £376.6m supported by very strong ATP and SPP (£5.99 & £3.34 respectively) driven by the expansion of price optimisation to additional sites and strong performance from refurbished recliner sites, retail initiatives and film mix.
- H1 FY23 delivered £23.3m EBITDAaL with £0.2m of covid revenue subsidies and £8.0m of Italian tax credits compared to H1 FY22 of £11.4m and £1.3m respectively.
- One new site (Netherlands: Enschede) opened in December and is now the 5th highest admissions cinema in the Vue Netherlands circuit.
- Salerno (Italy) and Berlin (Germany) reopened in December and February
 as fully reclined sites following refurbishment. Limena (Italy) re-opened as
 a 14 screen fully reclined site following refurbishment in April.
- Unrestricted cash balance at the end of H1 was £111.9m. Landlord deferrals reduced to £14.8m.
- Avatar: The Way of Water surpassed the \$2 billion box office mark becoming the 3rd highest grossing film of all time and largest film of all time in Germany.
- Mario Bros. saw the strongest opening performance of any animation since the pandemic and has become the second biggest animation in history.
- The UK and Ireland achieved number one market share for event content.
